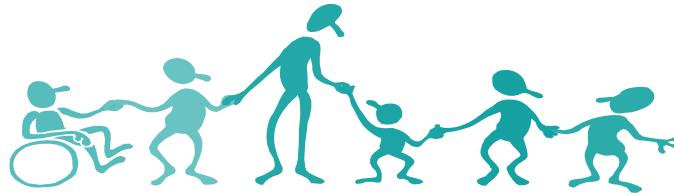
Community Support
